NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a regular public meeting at **1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas**, said address being a meeting place of the District. The meeting will be held on **Tuesday, July 7, 2026, at 12:00 Noon**. Said meeting may also be accessed by members of the public for observation purposes via telephone. The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public Comments;
2. Review and approve the minutes of the June 2, 2026, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Ratify acceptance of Qualification Statement, Bond, Oath of Office, Affidavit of Current Director, and Election Not to Disclose Certain Information for Director Olsen;
4. Report from Montgomery County Constable's Office regarding the provision of security services within the District;
5. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
6. Consider status of audit report for fiscal year ended March 31, 2026 (filing deadline August 13, 2026);
7. Report by Republic Services, Inc. concerning solid waste and recycling collection activities within the District;
8. Status of the District's Stormwater Management Program ("SWMP"), including any training necessary under the SWMP and comments from the public; Drainage Facilities Report and status of associated maintenance;
9. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented and approve moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
10. Report and legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collection attorney, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim; authorize termination of water service as a means of collection of delinquent taxes and to prevent abuses;

 - (a) Authorizing the repair and maintenance of, or measures to protect, District facilities, including:
 - (i) Proposals for repair/replacement of lift pumps located at Lift Station No. 2;
 - (b) Appeals of District charges; and
 - (c) Referral of accounts for collection and approve write-off of uncollectible accounts;
12. Engineer's Report, including:
 - (a) Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids for construction and/or maintenance of facilities within the District, and acceptance of TEC Form 1295;
 - (b) Review and approval of any Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans related to construction within or on behalf of the District;
 - (c) Authorizing the award of construction contracts or concurrence of award of contracts for the construction and/or repair of facilities within the District;
 - (i) Cleaning and televising of sanitary sewer collection system;
 - (d) Status of construction and/or repair of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any pay estimates and/or change orders;
 - (i) Construction of new concrete Wastewater Treatment Plant by Reytec Construction Resources, Inc., on behalf of Montgomery County Municipal Utility District No. 119 ("No. 119") and District;
